General information and eligibility requirements Agreements

➤ *What is Transfer Admission Agreement/Guarantee (TAA/TAG)?*

It is a contract between students and four year universities that is offered to eligible students who are seeking guaranteed admission to universities.

Transfer Admission Agreements (TAA) is offered by:

- California State Universities (CSU)
- Private Schools

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) is offered by:

- University of California (UC)

➤ *How many contracts may be signed at one time?*

As many as possible if the eligibility requirements are met.

➤ *What are the general eligibility requirements?*

- have successfully completed 30 transferable units
- have met the GPA requirement of the university of choice
- completed 60 transferable units by the end of proceeding transfer semester

For example: if transferring in Fall 2009, all required courses must have been completed by the end of Spring 2009

- Must be a community college student

TAA may not apply to all programs

➤ *How can I find what courses are transferrable?* Please meet with your academic counselor and bring a copy of your transcripts from all colleges attended, and the results of AP exams if there is any. You may also go to www.assist.org to find a list of transferrable courses.

➤ *What is my Transfer GPA?*

Total completed Transfer units /Total points = Total transfer GPA

Please see your counselor or meet with the Transfer program Supervisor/Counselor.

➤ *Where can I find the Transfer agreement forms?*

The Transfer agreement contract forms are available at the Transfer Center. The Transfer agreement contract forms for the UC campuses are available on line at: http://www.uctransfer.org/transfer_admis_guar.html

Instructions:

1. Meet with your counselor to discuss your major and your eligibility, including course transferability, and transfer GPA.
2. Complete a TAA/TAG form, if required (some universities do not have the formal agreement contract form).
3. Meet with Transfer Center Coordinator to finalize your contract for submission to universities.
5. Must complete and submit the university general admission application by the university application deadline. Do not wait for the last minute; make an appointment with your counselor now.

Note: TAA/TAG does not apply to impacted and selected programs.
