At the culmination of the course, students will have attained the following outcomes:

1. An understanding of color in all its aspects including physical, sociological and psychological applications.
2. An understanding of the inextricable link between color and light.
3. Be able to neutralize color by four different methods: black, white, gray, and the hue's complement.
4. Be able to identify and create color schemes including complementary, split complementary, analagous and monochromatic as applied to interiors.

**Methods of Assessment**

Assessment is done by pre and post tests, series of eleven unit tests and a final examination. All projects presented in class are assessed by instructor and peer evaluation using critique format.
