Course Policies:

• **Course Communication Policy:**

Email is the best way to contact me. If you email me Monday through Friday, you should hear back from me within 24 hours; if not, you may want to resend the email. When emailing, make sure to include your name and the class you belong to. (For Example: "- Ray Lapuz, Math 110")

• **Add/Drop Policy:**

The last day to add a semester long class is Tues, Aug 30. The last day to drop a class is Wed, Aug 31. The last day to drop a class without a "W" (withdraw) in your transcript is Fri, Sept 9. The last day to drop a class with a "W" is Tues, Nov 15. If you decide to drop the class, make sure you drop before these due dates in <https://websmart.smccd.edu>; if you don't drop in time, you will receive a grade.
